Internet Use Agreement

It is the belief of Macon County Schools that access to the Internet and other computer resources should be available to all students, faculty, and staff. The Internet and other computer and information resources offer vast, diverse, and unique resources that can educate and inform. These resources have an important place as educational tools in our schools by facilitating information sharing, innovation, and communication.

Macon County Schools has taken strong precautions to prevent access to controversial and inappropriate materials using content filtering technology; however, on a global network, it is impossible to control all materials and information. It is the belief of Macon County Schools that the valuable information, resources and collaboration available on the Internet are worthwhile, even though the possibility exists for access to materials, which may not be educationally appropriate.

Any student that is allowed access to the Internet must read and comply with Macon County School's Acceptable Use Policy (Policy 630).

If a parent or guardian, **DOES NOT** wish a student to have access to the Internet, he or she must acknowledge the following statement by initialing the statement, then sign and return this form to your schools administration.
