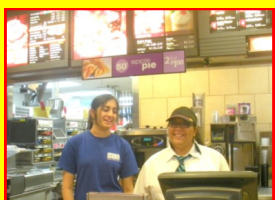

MEC Unexcused Tardy Policy Effective 1-5-12

Students are expected to arrive to school and all classes on time. Punctuality is essential to promoting a learning environment that is free of classroom interruptions.

Unexcused tardies will be recorded for each student who arrives after the official start time to school or is not in the assigned class at the beginning of a class period.

After three (3) unexcused tardies, the student will be required to serve detention before or after school, or during lunch. Unexcused tardies are cumulative for each nine (9) week period.

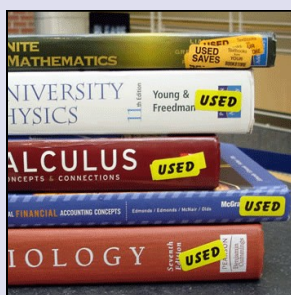
Tissue Boxes
