

The Macon County Board of Education held their regular scheduled meeting on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at Highlands School. Board Members Jim Breedlove, Fred Goldsmith, Tommy Cabe, Stephanie McCall and Melissa Evans were present as well as Superintendent Dr. Chris Baldwin and Board Attorney John Henning, Jr.

Board Chairman Jim Breedlove called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the September meeting of the Macon County Board of Education.

Following a moment of silence, Board Vice Chairman Tommy Cabe along with students from Highlands School 5<sup>th</sup> grade led the Pledge of Allegiance.

On a motion made by Tommy Cabe and seconded by Stephanie McCall, the Board approved by a 5-0 vote minutes from the special called meeting of August 9, 2017 as presented.

On a motion made by Stephanie McCall and seconded by Melissa Evans, the Board approved by a 5-0 vote to adopt the agenda as presented.

There were no *Recognitions* at this time.

Under the *Presentations* section of the agenda, Mr. Brian Aulisio, Macon County Academic Foundation President, spoke to the Board about the Academic Foundation and its purpose throughout the county.

Chairman Jim Breedlove opened the floor for *Public Comment*. (1) Blake Morton, Harry Hurst, Daniel Lawton, Steven Dunmier, Maria Hawkins, Madison Ortiz, and Casey & Erica Wilson all spoke to the Board and expressed their support of a sign/banner that was displayed by the Franklin High School Cheerleaders at a recent football game. (2) Board Member Fred Goldsmith addressed the Board and the audience on behalf of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Mr. Goldsmith expressed his appreciation for Superintendent Dr. Chris Baldwin as well as the Macon County Board of Education for handling the cheerleading banner issue in an appropriate way. Mr. Goldsmith also referred to social media as “the devil” and asked everyone not to believe everything that has been placed on social media. (3) Board Chairman Jim Breedlove reminded everyone of Macon County School Board Policy #3515-Religion in Schools. Mr. Breedlove stated that social media can create a lot of stress and asked for the public to not believe everything they read on social media. Mr. Breedlove thanked everyone for sharing their concerns and showing their support and stated that no action would be taken on this matter. (4) Superintendent Dr. Chris Baldwin stated that two cheerleading parents had contacted him and asked that he meet with the cheerleading team regarding the banner. Dr. Baldwin met with the cheerleaders as well as held a meeting with their parents. Dr. Baldwin referred to this group of cheerleaders as “exceptional.” Dr. Baldwin thanked the Board of Education for the opportunity to work together through this issues and stated, “Our goal is to follow individual religious expression and free speech.” Dr. Baldwin reminded everyone of Board Policy #3515-Religion in Schools.

Prior to executive session, Mr. Mike Wike with Anderson, Smith, & Wike, PLLC, addressed the Board regarding the 2017 Audit Report. Mr. Wike was pleased to announce that Macon County Schools had received a clean audit report. Mr. Wike explained that building a fund balance among school systems may be necessary so that school systems can fund state mandated expenses without worry. Mr. Wike also stated that School Nutrition increased a little this year

and is going in the right direction. Mr. Wike thanked Macon County Schools for their cooperation throughout the audit.

On a motion made by Stephanie McCall and seconded by Tommy Cabe, the Board moved into executive session at 6:57 p.m. pursuant to **143-318.11.(a)(6)** *To consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment, or conditions of initial employment of an individual public officer or employee or prospective public officer or employee;* as well as **143-318.11.(a)(3)** *To consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged.*
