

The Macon County Board of Education held their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, April 29, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at South Macon Elementary School. Board Members Jim Breedlove, Tommy Cabe, Fred Goldsmith and Melissa Evans were present as well as Superintendent Dr. Chris Baldwin and Board Attorney John Henning Jr. Board Member Stephanie McCall was unable to attend. On a motion made by Tommy Cabe and seconded by Fred Goldsmith, Board Member Stephanie McCall was excused from the meeting.

Board Chairman Jim Breedlove called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the April meeting of the Macon County Board of Education.
